
In lieu of the above noted appeal, received December 2, 2025, by this court and according to (BRCI) received response on December 10, 2025, the mailroom notified him since December 11, 2025, to come pick up his mail. He wasn't allowed to do so until December 17, 2025, via institution account along with numerous other prisoners.

He will be addressing the court by mail asking for extension of time providing Administrative Law Court proof of service under applicable rules. As His power of attorney, due to no fault of his own, receiving his mail six (6) days after because of MTB dorm constantly or simply having no legal mail movement for various reasons, the court normally grants extension, even so.

I will then willingly pay the \$250.00 filing fee upon the judge granting extension for filing deadline. He has previously let the courts know that he has been denied getting his mail, SCDC taking weeks to give him his mail and to mail legal documents, causing him to be time barred with the courts.
