MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel respectfully requests a **final extension of thirty (30) days until December 20, 2013**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. **Nevertheless, counsel has discussed this matter with the Chief Appellate Defender, and counsel intends to file the brief by November 27, 2013, barring unforeseen circumstances.** This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a final request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court, today. The Court has granted counsel four previous extensions.
2. Counsel respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted

and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Today, counsel will file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Antrown Irby v. State with the Supreme Court. On November 13, 2013, counsel filed an initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Jon Roseboro in this Court. On November 7, 2013, counsel held an oral argument in State v. Carmichael Arvel Glenn before this Court. On November 6, 2013, counsel filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Korey Love with this Court. On November 4, 2013, counsel filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Wanda Patterson with this Court. On October 31, 2013, counsel filed a brief of appellant in State v. Samuel Dingle with this Court. On October 28, 2013, counsel filed the brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Andre Wallace with this Court. On October 17, 2013, counsel filed an initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Dietrick T. Williams in this Court. On October 7, 2013, counsel filed an initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Sarah D. Cardwell with this Court. On September 27, 2013, counsel filed a Brief of Appellant in State v. Demetrius Smalls with this Court. From September 23-25, 2013, counsel attended the 2013 Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach, S.C. On September 20, 2013, counsel attended a conference hosted by the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense entitled Gideon at 50 in Charleston, S.C.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions, first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested. **Counsel intends to file the brief by November 27, 2013, barring unforeseen circumstances.**

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.


