I am writing in response to your December 10, 2025, letter requesting conflict dates during the April 2026 term of court. With the exception of Mr. Shissias, all counsel involved in this case are involved in a related case between Lexington and West Columbia that is currently pending in the Lexington Co. Court of Common Pleas (C/A No. 2023-CP-32-01691). That case has been designated as a complex case and assigned to Judge Frank Addy. Judge Addy has set this case for a day-certain two-week trial starting on Monday, March 30, 2026. Thus, we expect to be in trial during the week of April 6. It would be difficult to be prepared for this argument during the following week of April based on that trial.

Also, I have discussed this with counsel for West Columbia, and I understand that they will be reporting conflicts unrelated to the aforementioned trial during the week of April 13. For those reasons, we are requesting that this case be continued beyond the April term of court to a later term during 2026.
