ORDER

On December 3, 2025, Respondent moved to expedite this appeal. On December 9, 2025, Appellant filed a return, expressing no objection to the motion to expedite as long as its initial brief and designation of matter remained due on January 28, 2026, and its initial reply would not be due until twenty days after service of Respondent's initial brief and designation of matter. On December 11, 2025, Respondent filed a reply, asking this court to require Appellant to serve and file its initial brief and designation of matter by December 19, 2025. After careful consideration, we grant Respondent's motion to expedite to the extent it requests an expedited briefing schedule. Appellant shall serve and file its initial brief and designation of matter no later than January 28, 2026. Respondent shall serve and file its initial brief and designation of matter no later than thirty days after service of Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter. Thereafter, Appellant shall have ten days to serve and file its initial reply brief. No extensions will be granted absent extraordinary circumstances. To the extent, Respondent requests expedited consideration of the appeal, the request is denied as premature. *See Maner v. Maner*, 278 S.C. 377, 380, 296 S.E.2d 533, 535 (1982) (explaining that motions to expedite were premature in cases where the briefs remained outstanding).
