ORDER

On September 2, 2025, Appellant filed an amended record on appeal. On November 6, 2025, Respondents St. Matthews Police Department and Town of Saint Matthews (Respondents) filed a motion to strike the amended record on appeal because it is not paginated completely, lacks consecutive pagination, includes items not designated, and excludes designated items. Further, Respondents moved for leave to serve and file a second amended record on appeal and conditionally filed a second amended record on appeal. On November 17, 2025, Appellant filed a return, objecting to striking the amended record on appeal. After careful consideration of the filings, we grant the motion to strike the amended record on appeal filed on September 2, 2025. Further, we grant the motion for leave to serve and file a second amended record on appeal. We accept the conditionally-filed second amended record on appeal.
