APPELLANTS’ MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
FILE THEIR INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF  
MATTER TO BE INCLUDED IN THE RECORD ON  
APPEAL

Pursuant to Rule 240 of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Practice, Appellants RECO Commercial Systems LLC (improperly identified as RECO Commercial Systems, LLC f/k/a RECO USA) and Dunbar Road LLC (collectively “Appellants”) move this Court for an Order granting an extension of time during which to file their Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. For the reasons set forth below, Appellants request an additional period of thirty days from January 6, 2026, during which to file these documents.
