Dear Ms. Kitchings,

This letter is submitted in response to this Court's December 16, 2025 correspondence advising the parties that no action will be taken on the Respondents' *Motion to Allow Late Filing*.

To clarify, Appellant filed a *Second Supplemental Motion to Strike*. Respondents filed a return to that motion, which the Court rejected as untimely. Respondents thereafter filed a *Motion to Allow Late Filing*, and Appellant filed a return opposing that motion. Respondents subsequently abandoned the motion by failing to pay the required filing fee.

Appellant's Reply to Respondents' Return, together with the attached affidavit and exhibits, was filed to address Respondents' factual assertion that the challenged document had been filed with, or properly before, the lower court. Those materials demonstrate that no such filing or presentation ever occurred.

Because no order permits consideration of Respondents' untimely return, Appellant does not seek to revive or rely upon that filing. Rather, out of an abundance of caution and to preserve the accuracy of the record, Appellant clarifies that the affidavit and exhibits submitted with her Reply should be treated as a supplemental evidentiary addendum in support of her *Second Supplemental Motion to Strike*.
