
**COMES NOW**, Hadi Bey, Ex Rel: Keyshon Anthony Poinsette Jr., appearing specially, and respectfully submits the following supplemental facts in support of the previously filed Motion for Continuance:

1. **Date of Receipt of Discovery Video** – On **July 17, 2025**, Movant received a flash drive containing video footage of the traffic stop from the Solicitor’s Office.
2. **Denial of Timely Access to Evidence** – Due to incarceration in another county’s jail, Movant was denied the ability to view the footage until **Thursday, August 7, 2025**, just 3-4 days before the currently scheduled trial date of **Monday, August 11, 2025**.
3. **Material Exculpatory Evidence in Video** – Upon viewing the footage for the first time, Movant observed that:
  - o The video clearly shows he did **not** run a stop sign as alleged by the arresting officer.
  - o The officer claimed the vehicle’s window tint was illegal but made **no measurement or test** of the tint.
4. **Seizure of Exculpatory Document** – The arresting officer also seized Movant’s official **SLED-stamped fingerprint and name change document**—which had been lawfully processed and returned by the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division—as part of the stop. This seizure:
  - o Was conducted without due process or lawful justification.
  - o Was **omitted entirely** from the officer’s affidavit and narrative reports.
  - o Directly supports Movant’s lawful intent and absence of criminal mens rea, consistent with his secured rights to self-identification and free national name change under the **First and Ninth Amendments**, and protections recognized under international law.
5. **Ongoing Prejudice** – The late access to critical evidence, combined with the withholding of material exculpatory documents, has deprived Movant of adequate time to investigate, prepare, and incorporate these facts into his defense strategy.

**WHEREFORE**, Movant respectfully requests that this Court:

- Accept this Notice of Supplemental Facts as part of the record supporting his Motion for Continuance; and
- Grant sufficient additional time for full review, investigation, and preparation in light of the newly revealed exculpatory evidence and due process violations.
