(WHEREUPON, proceedings commenced at 10:03 AM.)

THE COURT: Sir, you are Jacob Ryan Mims?

DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

THE COURT: Mr. Mims, you are in custody. Give your attention, please, to Madam Clerk.

THE CLERK: Raise your right hand, please.

WHEREUPON,

JACOB RYAN MIMS

After having been duly sworn, testified as follows:

THE COURT: In 2023-GS-42-2233, the State says that you did, on or about December 19, 2022, in Spartanburg County, South Carolina, while under the supervision of the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office escaped from home detention by cutting your ankle monitor and fleeing from law enforcement in violation of state law. It was true billed by the grand jury. You are pleading as indicted. It's nonviolent. It carries up to ten years; do you understand?

DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

THE COURT: In 2023-GS-42-2227, the State says that you did, in Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on or about December 21, 2022, drive a motor vehicle on a public highway of this state when your license to drive was canceled, suspended or revoked and that you have

1 previously been convicted of driving under suspension two  
2 times within the previous five years in violation of law.  
3 It was true billed by the grand jury. You're pleading to  
4 the indictment. It's nonviolent. It carries up to 90  
5 days and/or a fine of up to a thousand dollars; do you  
6 understand?

7 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

8 THE COURT: In 2024-GS-42-2843, the State says that  
9 you did, in Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on or  
10 about December 21, 2022, offer or attempt to injure a  
11 deputy with the present ability to do so and the act was  
12 accomplished by means likely to produce death or great  
13 bodily injury, that is, driving head on towards the  
14 deputy's vehicle during a police chase in violation of  
15 state law. That matter has not been presented to the  
16 grand jury. I understand you desire to waive presentment.  
17 It's nonviolent by definition. It carries with it up to  
18 ten years. Do you understand?

19 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

20 THE COURT: 2023-GS-42-5965, the State says that you  
21 did, in Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on or about  
22 September 1, 2023, knowingly and with the intent to  
23 defraud, falsely make, forge, counterfeit, cause or  
24 procured to be falsely made, forged, or counterfeited an  
25 instrument of writing and/or utter or publish as true a

1 false, forged or counterfeit writing and/or willingly  
2 assisted in the above, that being a signature on a title  
3 for a motor vehicle belonging to the victim valued at less  
4 than \$10,000, in violation of state law. That matter was  
5 true billed by the grand jury. You're pleading to the  
6 indictment. It carries up to ten years. It's nonviolent  
7 by definition. Do you understand?

8 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

9 THE COURT: 2023-GS-42-2229, the State says that you  
10 did, in Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on or about  
11 December 19, 2022, operate a motor vehicle after having  
12 been declared an habitual offender by the Department of  
13 Motor Vehicles in violation of state law. It has been  
14 true billed by the grand jury. You're pleading to the  
15 indictment. It's nonviolent. It carries up to five  
16 years. Do you understand?

17 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

18 THE COURT: 2023-GS-42-2224 says that you did, in  
19 Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on or about  
20 December 21, 2022, willfully fail to stop a motor vehicle  
21 that you were driving on a road, street or highway of this  
22 state when signaled by law enforcement by means of a siren  
23 or flashing light in violation of state law. That matter  
24 was true billed by the grand jury. You're pleading to the  
25 indictment. It's nonviolent. It carries up to five

1 years. Do you understand what I said?

2 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

3 THE COURT: 2023-GS-42-2230 says that you did in  
4 Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on or about  
5 December 19, 2022, willfully failed to stop the motor  
6 vehicle that you were driving on a road, street or highway  
7 of this state when you were signaled by law enforcement by  
8 means of a siren or flashing light in violation of law.  
9 It was true billed by the grand jury. You're pleading to  
10 the indictment. It's nonviolent. It carries up to five  
11 years. Did you hear what I said?

12 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

13 THE COURT: 2023-GS-42-2228 alleges that you did, on  
14 or about December 21, 2022, in Spartanburg County, South  
15 Carolina, operate a motor vehicle after having been  
16 declared an habitual offender by the Department of Motor  
17 Vehicles. It was true billed by the grand jury. You're  
18 pleading to the indictment. It's nonviolent. It carries  
19 up to five years. Do you understand?

20 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

21 THE COURT: 2023-GS-42-2226 alleges that you did, in  
22 Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on or about  
23 December 21, 2022, willfully and unlawfully violate the  
24 provisions of this motor vehicle statute in that you drove  
25 a vehicle in a manner as to indicate either a willful or

1 wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property in  
2 violation of law. It was true billed by the grand jury.  
3 You're pleading to the indictment. It's nonviolent. It  
4 carries up to 30 days. Do you understand?

5 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

6 THE COURT: 2023-GS-42-5966 alleges that you did, in  
7 Spartanburg County, South Carolina, on or about  
8 October 9, 2023, knowingly sell, manufacture, deliver,  
9 purchase or bring into this state, or provided financial  
10 assistance, or aided, abetted, attempted or conspired to  
11 sell, manufacture, deliver or bring into this state, or  
12 actually are constructively knowingly and actually  
13 possessed more than 10 grams of methamphetamine in  
14 violation of state law. That matter was true billed by  
15 the grand jury. You're offering to plead to the lesser  
16 offense known as PWID second. It carries between five  
17 years and 30 years and/or a fine of up to \$50,000. It is  
18 nonviolent by definition. Do you understand?

19 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

20 THE COURT: You have the right to a trial by jury on  
21 all of these indictments. Do you want a trial by jury?

22 DEFENDANT MIMS: No, sir.

23 THE COURT: Are you sure?

24 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

25 THE COURT: You have the right to call anyone up here

1 that you want to testify for you and confront anyone who  
2 testifies against you. Do you waive and give up that  
3 right?

4 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

5 THE COURT: You have the right to remain silent under  
6 the constitutions of the state and the federal government.  
7 Do you waive and give up that right?

8 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

9 THE COURT: And on the Indictment 2024-2843, you have  
10 the right to have this one presented to the grand jury.  
11 Do you waive and give up that right?

12 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

13 THE COURT: How do you offer to plead to 2024-2843?

14 DEFENDANT MIMS: Guilty, sir.

15 THE COURT: 2023-5966?

16 DEFENDANT MIMS: Guilty, sir.

17 THE COURT: 2023-2226?

18 DEFENDANT MIMS: Guilty, sir.

19 THE COURT: 2023-2228?

20 DEFENDANT MIMS: Guilty, sir.

21 THE COURT: 2023-2230?

22 DEFENDANT MIMS: Guilty, sir.

23 THE COURT: 2023-2224?

24 DEFENDANT MIMS: Guilty, sir.

25 THE COURT: 2023-2229?

1 DEFENDANT MIMS: Guilty, sir.

2 THE COURT: 2023-5965?

3 DEFENDANT MIMS: Guilty, sir.

4 THE COURT: 2023-2227?

5 DEFENDANT MIMS: Guilty, sir.

6 THE COURT: 2023-2232 [sic]?

7 DEFENDANT MIMS: Guilty, sir.

8 THE COURT: And do you plead guilty to all

9 indictments because you are guilty of all offenses?

10 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

11 THE COURT: Anyone force you, threaten you or make  
12 you plead guilty?

13 DEFENDANT MIMS: No, sir.

14 THE COURT: Did your lawyer explain the elements of  
15 each of these offenses?

16 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

17 THE COURT: Did your lawyer explain to you the burden  
18 is on the State of South Carolina to prove your guilt  
19 beyond a reasonable doubt?

20 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

21 THE COURT: Did your lawyer share discovery materials  
22 with you?

23 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

24 THE COURT: Has your lawyer done everything that he  
25 can to help you?

1           DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

2           THE COURT: If you have any complaints about your  
3 lawyer, you have to tell me now. She's recording. Do you  
4 have any complaints?

5           DEFENDANT MIMS: No, sir.

6           THE COURT: You're satisfied with your lawyer's  
7 services?

8           DEFENDANT MIMS: I'm satisfied.

9           THE COURT: Please listen to the solicitor.

10          MR. SMITH: Your Honor, just to clarify something.  
11 He was represented by Katrice Lyles, and I guess they're  
12 taking over these. Can we just cover that he's all right  
13 with her? She's not here present in the courtroom. I  
14 know this was on the trial docket maybe last term or the  
15 term before and Katrice and Chris were meeting with him  
16 trying to reach basically the resolution we're reaching  
17 here today. So I know that they were kind of working it  
18 together, but just want to make sure that -- I guess  
19 there's not been a formal substitution order, but that  
20 he's comfortable proceeding with them. I know he said he  
21 was satisfied, but ---

22          THE COURT: All right. Mr. Mims, are you satisfied  
23 with the services of these lawyers, Mr. Chris Thompson and  
24 Mr. Matthew Sterling?

25          DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

1 THE COURT: Starling. I'm sorry.

2 You're all right? You're happy with them?

3 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

4 THE COURT: All right. He's happy.

5 MR. THOMPSON: We did discuss that with Mr. Moran  
6 also, Your Honor.

7 THE COURT: Okay.

8 MR. SMITH: You want the facts, Your Honor?

9 THE COURT: Yes, sir.

10 MR. SMITH: All right. Your Honor, the first case  
11 arose on December 19, 2022. Deputies initiated a traffic  
12 stop on the suspect vehicle for an improper lane change.  
13 This was on Asheville Highway in Spartanburg County. The  
14 driver identified himself as Jacob Mims. He indicated he  
15 was currently on home detention. His license was run and  
16 came back being suspended as well as being a habitual  
17 traffic offender.

18 Deputies went to speak with him and asked him to step  
19 out. At that point, he accelerated away and a chase  
20 ensued. During this chase, he threw his ankle monitor out  
21 of the window. The chase was called off due to the danger  
22 of his driving.

23 Deputies eventually found the suspect car had struck  
24 a tree and the suspect had fled on foot. They were not  
25 able to find him that day.

1           The pursuit lasted 11 miles and got up to 90 miles an  
2 hour on the interstate.

3           He was a habitual traffic offender from August 5,  
4 2021, to the same date in 2026. And he was driving in the  
5 opposite lane at times during this chase, Your Honor.

6           The next set of charges come from December 21, 2022.  
7 Deputies were on Walnut Grove Road searching for the  
8 defendant. They had a suspected vehicle that he may be  
9 in.

10           They did arrive at a residence, and as they  
11 approached, that suspect vehicle actually began driving  
12 through the yard of the house and a chase, again, ensued.  
13 This chase went down Walnut Grove Road to Price House Road  
14 to Hobbysville Road on 221. He then get on westbound in  
15 the eastbound lane of that would be 26. Sheriff Wright  
16 was involved, authorized them to wreck him if they got an  
17 opportunity due to the danger that was -- the public was  
18 in. Fortunately, he decided to voluntarily pull over into  
19 the median and eventually surrender himself to the  
20 officers. He went about a mile down the interstate, and  
21 I'm going to show a clip of that, just the end portion of  
22 that chase, Your Honor.

23           So he -- I have a timeline I'm going to go over  
24 events, Your Honor. But just factually, then on  
25 September 5, 2023, deputies were called to a report of a

1 stolen vehicle. The owner was in jail. Actually, it was  
2 like a girlfriend of Mr. Mims so the father had called.  
3 He had indicated that Jacob Mims had come by trying to get  
4 the vehicle the previous day but he would not give it to  
5 him, and the next day the car just was gone.

6 A title had been requested by the defendant. That  
7 title was then registered with the DMV showing a sale  
8 between the victim and the defendant. This title is  
9 forged as the original title was still in the possession  
10 of the title holder, and the defendant and victim were in  
11 jail at the time that the alleged transfer had occurred.

12 On October 9, 2023, deputies were, again, searching  
13 for the stolen car in Spartanburg County, the stolen car  
14 connected to the forgery, when they found Mr. Mims at the  
15 location in Spartanburg County actively spray painting  
16 that car. They did find some fentanyl, which we are  
17 dismissing that charge, and they found a slightly over  
18 10 grams amount of meth in an Acura that was also on the  
19 scene.

20 Your Honor, I didn't cover this earlier, but we are  
21 dismissing a resisting arrest, a possession with intent to  
22 distribute fentanyl, a receiving stolen goods, a resisting  
23 arrest, a removing, destroying monitoring device and a  
24 host of traffic tickets that they wrote him for on the  
25 second chase in addition to the reduction in the

1 trafficking charge and the driving under suspension  
2 charge.

3 I would like to play a portion of this video here,  
4 Your Honor, and then just kind of go over a timeline of  
5 the various events. And I have an argument on his credit  
6 for time served I'd like as well.

7 (WHEREUPON, a video recording is played in open court.)

8 MR. SMITH: Your Honor, just to go over kind of a  
9 timeline of everything that happened with Mr. Mims, he was  
10 in jail on November 8, 2022, to November 23, 2022, on a  
11 probation warrant. That was for a charge that you're  
12 going to hear about in his prior record. He was released  
13 on November 23rd on a one-year home detention sentence by  
14 Judge Knie. On December 19th is when he then ran from the  
15 traffic stop, so that's about four weeks later where he  
16 throws the ankle monitor. He was then arrested after the  
17 second car chase on December 21st on the home detention  
18 and the charges from the second car chase and the first  
19 car chase.

20 He did not max out his home detention sentence until  
21 July 30, 2023, so the State is completely opposed to him  
22 getting any credit until at least that date, though we  
23 don't believe he's entitled to any credit.

24 He then bonded out on the other charges on  
25 August 15th. Two months later on October 9th he was

1 arrested for the forgery. He bonded out the next day.  
2 One month and some change later on November 29, 2023, he  
3 failed to appear for a bond revocation hearing and his  
4 bond was revoked by Judge Cole.

5 On December 19, 2023, deputies got out with him in a  
6 foot chase and he was able to allude them. The sheriff  
7 actually gave a press conference declaring him the most  
8 wanted person in Spartanburg, and he was arrested on the  
9 23rd and has remained in jail since.

10 But, Your Honor, our argument on the credit for time  
11 is the new statute that came in with the bond says that  
12 you don't get credit if your bond is revoked on any  
13 charges. His bond has been revoked on all of the pending  
14 charges other than the forgery and the trafficking charge  
15 that he's pleading guilty to. So I'm not disputing the  
16 fact that he's been in jail, but I don't think the law  
17 entitles him to any credit, and I certainly don't think  
18 that it entitles him to any credit prior to him completing  
19 the sentence he was on from Judge Knie while he  
20 essentially completed that in the county detention center.

21 Your Honor, his prior record is 2009, reckless  
22 driving and driving under suspension; 2010, public  
23 disorderly, possession of alcohol and trespassing; 2011,  
24 burglary second and possession of alcohol; 2013, two  
25 assault and battery thirds and a malicious injury to

1 personal property; 2015, breaking into motor vehicles;  
2 2017, possession of meth, failure to stop, driving under  
3 the influence and no registration; 2020, two driving under  
4 suspensions; 2021, two A&B thirds, a DUS, DUI, failure to  
5 stop second offense times two, and a resisting arrest.  
6 Those were cases I handled. He was also charged with  
7 driving at officers in that case. That's what the assault  
8 and battery charges are. So these are his fourth and  
9 fifth times that he's run from law enforcement, both of  
10 them while he was basically wanted. And then in 2023, he  
11 has a DUS conviction that's connected to the December 19th  
12 arrest.

13 He has been on probation four times since 2011  
14 according to -- I believe it was Agent Smith told me that  
15 last time we had him in court.

16 So, Your Honor, put a lot of people in danger. He  
17 has a bad record. He's doing the same type of conduct  
18 that he's been doing in the past, so we think he's a  
19 danger to the community and he needs to be sent to prison.

20 THE COURT: Sir, did you hear what the solicitor told  
21 me?

22 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

23 THE COURT: Is all that true?

24 DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir.

25 THE COURT: The Court accepts all pleas as being

1 freely, intelligently and voluntarily given.

2 Mr. Starling?

3 MR. STARLING: May it please the Court, Your Honor.

4 THE COURT: Yes.

5 MR. STARLING: Mr. Mims is 32 years old. He has a  
6 GED education. No college but a certificate in welding.  
7 His prior employment has been mechanical and welding  
8 background. He's not currently on probation or anything  
9 of that nature.

10 But upon talking with Mr. Mims, I believe a lot of  
11 his life troubles with crime and his personal life has  
12 been surrounded by drugs. And he started using drugs at  
13 14 years old. He became a chronic user at 18 years old,  
14 you know. And his addiction has stood into the crimes  
15 that we're here for today and pleading to. He was on  
16 drugs when he committed these crimes, you know. He's  
17 taken full responsibility and feels remorseful for what  
18 has occurred.

19 And we're not in disagreeance with the Solicitor  
20 Smith about, you know, the new statute and, you know,  
21 certain situations that Mr. Mims has fallen into. His  
22 time that he has been incarcerated doesn't count.  
23 However, we still state that he has, by my calculations  
24 with these crimes together, has spent around 450 days  
25 incarcerated at Spartanburg County Detention Center. And

1 although this time doesn't count, he does feel as though  
2 it's been good for him. Says it's the first time in his  
3 life that he's felt clearheaded and he's thought about  
4 what he needs to do with his life and what the next  
5 chapter is and the priorities that he needs to do to get  
6 back on track.

7 I think the issue with Mr. Mims, he's never had any  
8 kind of structure in his life. He lost his father at 9.  
9 He's never had a role model besides his mother who is here  
10 today, Sherry Mims, you know. She's supporting him, and  
11 she's the only constant he's ever had in his life. And  
12 he's never obtained help to deal with these drugs. He's  
13 never been to rehab or anything of that nature.

14 And, Your Honor, may I approach to hand you a  
15 document?

16 THE COURT: Sure.

17 MR. STARLING: Solicitor Smith has reviewed this.  
18 And I highlighted just the important parts.

19 This is an email exchange between Mr. Thompson and  
20 Evans Training Center with Ben Dismiscus [phonetic]. I  
21 don't want to ruin his last name. And the highlighted  
22 part says that Mr. Thompson said do you have any space,  
23 bed available for him? And he says yes. And he said if  
24 the judge allows, would you consider him into your program  
25 and accept him? And he said yes as well.

1 I bring that up because, you know, it would be a  
2 first chance for him to have -- obtain some structure, a  
3 place where, you know, he's with the same individuals that  
4 have dealt with the same kind of drug issues in his past.  
5 And as I'm sure you're aware of Evans Training Center,  
6 that, you know, it's a ten-month program. They stay  
7 there. They allow for home detention monitoring to be on  
8 the person while they're residing there. They make them  
9 work, painting and landscaping. He is able-bodied. I  
10 mean, he doesn't have any kind of physical restraints that  
11 would impede him from working at the facility. And  
12 talking with his mother, and she would help pay the home  
13 detention monitor every month while he's at the program.

14 Your Honor, we're asking you to consider a high  
15 suspended sentence and he -- on ankle monitor and under  
16 the requirement that he would have to finish Evans  
17 Training Center, or if not, you know, he would be sent to  
18 prison. And I told Mr. Mims that if a judge would even  
19 consider this, it would be an astronomical amount of time  
20 over his head and, you know, one mess-up and you would go  
21 to prison the entire time. But for those reasons, that's  
22 what we ask, your Honor.

23 And I believe Mr. Mims has something to say as well.

24 THE COURT: Mr. Mims, I'm happy to hear from you,  
25 sir. Go ahead.

1           DEFENDANT MIMS: Yes, sir. I just want to let you  
2 know I made a mess of my life. I'm trying to get help. I  
3 understand the people's lives I put at danger on the  
4 highway. I'm thankful I'm here, that I didn't hurt  
5 somebody's mother, parent, you know what I'm saying,  
6 grandma or grandpa. Everything. I'm just thankful that  
7 God has seen me through that situation.

8           I want to let you know that when I was gave that home  
9 detention sentence, I actually showed up to court that day  
10 high, so high that my lawyer said if you will just sign  
11 this -- because I was shooting for rehab that day with  
12 Agent Taylor, and told me, you know, you're high, man, you  
13 know. You're high. I don't want you to go in front of  
14 the judge. So if you'll take this one-year home  
15 detention, you can go home on home detention.

16           So I turned that situation, a home -- a one-year home  
17 detention situation into all these charges because I  
18 wasn't -- I wasn't ready. I wasn't at a spot in my mind  
19 physically or mentally to do -- to do the home detention.  
20 So I never even went through the withdrawals to get off  
21 heroin before I was right back on the bracelet.

22           And I went in fight or flight mode that day, and I  
23 turned it into a horrible situation that put a lot of  
24 people at harm's way. And I know that. And I do  
25 understand that this program, if I was to mess it up, that

1 it's over for me, you know.

2 And I've actually had a chance to sit and talk with  
3 the guy in the dorm I'm in that had the same opportunity,  
4 and he messed it up. And he's in a bad situation. And I  
5 know God put me in there, put me to talk to so that I'll  
6 take this serious, that I don't take this lightly. And I  
7 know my head's clear enough to handle this program with --  
8 God's blessed me through so much. Like he's seen me  
9 through a lot, you know. And I just don't think he's  
10 brought me this far to make me come -- make something else  
11 happen bad in my life.

12 I feel like, you know, there's half these guys over  
13 there I can't wait to get to prison to get high. I can't,  
14 you know. Like I'm scared to go down there and get high  
15 because I'll be right back here because I'll get -- I'll  
16 have to get out on probation or parole already strung out,  
17 you know what I'm saying? And I -- like I -- just whether  
18 I go to jail or not, I want to be able to do this program  
19 before I'm out, before I'm released from the Department of  
20 Corrections or jail.

21 I know that I've been serving dead time, and I've  
22 been aware of that and I've been okay with that because,  
23 you know, simply there's no drugs in the county jail. I  
24 -- I will sit as long as I have to. That's what I had in  
25 my mind, sit as long as I've got to in this county jail

1 with hopes that I have a chance of something like this, a


