Please find attached, for filing in the above-captioned matter, the following: (1) Appellant's Initial Brief; (2) Appellant's Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal; and (3) Proof of Service of Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter.

Also attached is a cover letter regarding the foregoing. Additionally, and as discussed in our letter, the lower court entered an order in the underlying matter on October 24, 2024, which requires the parties' public filings to contain redactions of any quoted text from the transcript of a specific deposition taken in the matter.
