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## ORDER

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On December 10, 2025, this court dismissed this appeal because Appellant failed to provide a redacted copy of the order(s) under appeal, a guilty plea explanation, and proof the notice of appeal was filed in the Dorchester County Clerk of Court as required by Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules and this Court's letter dated October 30, 2025. On December 12, 2025, Appellant filed a motion to allow late filing of the documents necessary to cure the deficiencies. Also, on December 12, 2025, Respondent sent a letter stating it had no objection to Appellant's request to file late or to this court rescinding the dismissal order. After careful consideration, we construe Appellant's motion to allow late filing as a motion to reinstate the appeal. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to reinstate and accept the documents filed on December 12, 2025. *See* Rule 260(a), SCACR ("A case shall not be reinstated except by leave of the court, upon good cause shown, after notice to all parties."). Further, we have reviewed Appellant's guilty plea explanation and we allow the appeal to proceed.
