

ORDER

Appellant filed a motion asking the Court to reconsider its deficiency letter asking for proof of service of the appellant's initial brief and designation of matter to counsel's street address, rather than to a P.O. Box. Austin Nichols, counsel for Respondent responded by email, which we construe as a return to the motion, and asserted that service to P.O. Box 1452, Columbia, SC 29202 is not an appropriate address for service. Appellant filed a supplement to the motion, which we construe as a reply.

In another matter pending before this Court, Austin Nichols has made filings on letterhead for The Rutherford Law Firm, which includes P.O. Box 1452, Columbia, SC 29202 as an address for the firm.¹ After careful consideration, we grant Appellant's motion and accept the appellant's initial brief and designation of matter as served and filed. The respondent's initial brief and designation of matter are due no later than thirty (30) days from the date of this letter.
