Objection to Writ of Supersedeas and Status of Record

Dear Clerk of the Court of Appeals,

We are writing to notify the Court of a material issue concerning the writ of supersedeas entered by the lower court pursuant to this Court's August 13, 2025 order.

The writ of supersedeas entered by the Honorable Judge Mattie Murphy is inaccurate and incomplete. The writ references and relies upon exhibits that the lower court has never reviewed and that are missing from the record. Despite this, the writ was issued without the court having examined the full set of exhibits submitted by the Appellants.

Additionally, the lower court improperly allowed input from Defendant D.R. Horton in the drafting and substance of the writ of supersedeas. A defendant should not have participation or influence in the preparation of a supersedeas intended to preserve the status quo during an appeal. This participation further undermines the validity of the writ as entered.

The Appellants formally objected to the writ of supersedeas in the lower court on **December 27, 2025**, on the grounds that it is factually incorrect, procedurally improper, and based on an incomplete and unreviewed record.

Because the writ of supersedeas is defective and does not accurately reflect the record or this Court's intent, we respectfully notify the Court of Appeals of this objection so the appellate record is clear and complete.
