I Djuan Holland received an order to pay my Appeal filing fee to the Bankruptcy Court within 21 days since receiving the order. Since then, there have been updated changes. I received mail November 17, 2025, from Morgan R Dunn and yes, I've done a response. I didn't pay the filing for the following reasons: (1) Morgan R Dunn doesn't always tell the complete truth because at the time that she has filed what she filed to the court she knowingly knew that I had until November 19, 2025 to pay the \$50 filing fee which I did mail to the Appeal Court on November 18, 2025, Morgan R Dunn also says that I allege about speaking to court staff and no providing names well Yesterday at the Appeal Court I spoke with Ms. Shelby Spencer and I also sent in a copy of my call log that I've called when the filing fee was in question and I was also told again by Ms. Shelby Spencer that they do take in consideration bankruptcy filing, which Morgan R Dunn has stated that I blamed court staff for providing me the wrong inform which clearly was told to me again by a court Staff member by the name Ms. Shelby Spencer. Morgan R Dunn had stated that I hadn't paid my Chapter 7 Bankruptcy fee which I had paid on it, and Judge Gasparini had given me until October 31, 2025, to pay the balance which was paid.

(2) Like I've always said about a discrepancy in the resident log about what is owed, it's the same in this order on page 2 of 3 it states there is no indication from the Bankruptcy Court records that Appellant has paid the required \$289.00 filing.

Then (1) it states a filing fee of \$ 298.00 is to be paid now which one is it, remember the court wants everything to be correct well something isn't correct here.

(3) Then reason that my installment for the filing fee was denied by Judge Gasparini was because she said I hadn't paid my Bankruptcy filing fee, since then everything has been paid.

(4) By law I am entitled to an Appeal, and I'm asking the court to GRANT me my installment to pay my Appeal filing since everything is paid to the Bankruptcy Court, and Appeal Court.
