MOTION FOR ATTORNEY’S FEES AND COSTS

The Respondents Grant Meisner, Grant Meisner, MD, LLC, Sheila Robinson, Moore, Taylor & Thomas, P.A., Moore Taylor Law Firm, P.A., and Moore Bradley Myers Law Firm, P.A. respectfully move this Court for an award of attorney’s fees to be assessed against the Appellant Rhonda Meisner in accordance with the provisions of Rule 222(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, and in support of this motion state as follows:

1. Appellant filed her Notice of Appeal on February 15, 2023, concerning Case No. 2023-000232 (Prior Appeal).
2. On April 6, 2023, Respondents Grant Meisner, Grant Meisner, MD, LLC, Sheila Robinson, Moore Taylor & Thomas, PA, Moore Taylor Law Firm, PA, and Moore

Bradley Myers Law Firm, PA (“Meisner Respondents”) filed a motion to join the motion made by Respondents Richard G. Whiting and the Law Offices of Richard G. Whiting, P.A. to dismiss Appellant’s appeal and paid a filing fee of \$50.00 to file that motion.

3. By order filed June 6, 2023, Appellant’s prior appeal was dismissed because it was not timely filed.

4. This Court issued the remittitur on June 23, 2023.

5. On June 29, 2023, the Meisner Respondents filed a motion for costs and attorney’s fees.

6. On July 28, 2023, this Court issued an Order granting that motion. The Court awarded the Meisner Respondents \$1,000 in attorney’s fees.

7. Appellant has not complied with that order and has not paid the Meisner Respondents pursuant to that Order.

8. On December 1, 2023, Appellant filed a Motion to Alter or Amend seeking to have the trial court “clarify the dismissal of the Defendant’s Counterclaims against the Plaintiff,” and “to prevent further involvement of the dismissed Defendants in the proceedings.”

9. By order filed on August 19, 2024, the Court denied Appellant’s Motion to Alter or Amend.

10. On September 23, 2024, Appellant filed Notice of Appeal from that order.

11. On February 3, 2025, the Meisner Respondents filed a Motion to Dismiss Appellant’s Appeal and paid a filing fee of \$50.00 to file that motion.¹

¹ On February 3, 2025, Grant Meisner, Grant Meisner M.D., LLC, Sheila Robinson, Moore Taylor & Thomas P.A., Moore Taylor Law Firm P.A., and Moore Bradley Myers Law Firm, P.A. moved to dismiss the appeal, arguing the circuit court granted their motions to dismiss the underlying circuit court action by an order filed on December 15, 2022. However, Moore Bradley Myers Law Firm, P.A. was inadvertently

12. On February 10, 2025, Appellant filed a return, arguing that the appeal was proper as to the Meisner Respondents because at the time of this Court’s dismissal of the Prior Appeal, a post-trial motion filed by Appellant on January 11, 2023, remained pending.

13. By order filed on December 2, 2025, this Court found that the January 11, 2023, motion “not address any rulings related to Respondents Grant Meisner and Grant Meisner, M.D., LLC or Respondent Robinson.” The Court further found “[a]lthough the January 11, 2023 motion asked the circuit court to reconsider its dismissal of Moore Taylor & Thomas, P.A., Moore Taylor Law Firm, P.A., and Moore Bradley Myers Law Firm, P.A., it was successive and could not toll the time for serving a notice of appeal. Accordingly, this Court dismissed Appellant’s appeal as to the Meisner Respondents.

14. Respondents Grant Meisner, Grant Meisner, MD, LLC, Sheila Robinson, Moore, Taylor & Thomas, P.A., Moore Taylor Law Firm, P.A., and Moore Bradley Myers Law Firm, P.A. are entitled to recover costs and attorney’s fees pursuant to Rule 222(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

Wherefore, Respondents Grant Meisner, Grant Meisner, MD, LLC, Sheila Robinson, Moore, Taylor & Thomas, P.A., Moore Taylor Law Firm, P.A., and Moore Bradley Myers Law Firm, P.A. respectfully ask the Court to enter an order assessing attorney’s fees against Appellant Rhonda Meisner in the amount of \$2500 and costs of \$50.


