Dear Ms. Wiggins:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, you must provide the address where you served a copy of your notice of appeal on the respondent or their counsel.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00. If you wish to request relief from this Court, you must do so in the form of a motion pursuant to Rule 240 of the SCACR.

- The notice of appeal must include the name of the lower court judge, lower court county, and lower court case number.
- You must provide proof of filing a copy of your notice of appeal with the clerk of the lower court.
