Motion for Extension of Time

Pursuant to Rules 208 and 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules,
Respondent Representative Harry B. "Chip" Limehouse III ("Respondent Limehouse"),
moves this Court for an order granting an extension of time for Respondents to serve and
file Initial Briefs and Designations of Matter in the above-captioned action. Counsel for
Respondent Robert W. Harrell, Jr., in his official capacity as Speaker of the S.C. House
of Representatives; Respondent Glenn McConnell, in his official capacity as President of
the South Carolina Senate; Respondent Senator George E. "Chip" Campsen III, and
Respondent the State of South Carolina join in this extension request.

Currently, pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Court of Appeals filed November 1, 2013, Respondents' Initial Briefs and Designations of Matter are due on or about Wednesday, December 4, 2013. The undersigned Respondents request extensions of time as follows to file/serve Initial Briefs and Designations of Matter:

1. Respondent Robert W. Harrell, Jr., in his official capacity as Speaker of the S.C. House of Representatives; Glenn McConnell, in his official capacity as President of the South Carolina Senate, Respondent Representative Harry B. "Chip" Limehouse III; and Respondent Senator George E. "Chip" Campsen, request a 30-day extension to January 3, 2014.


2. Respondent the State of South Carolina requests that its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter be due three (3) business days after the filing of the other Respondents' Initial Briefs and Designations of Matter.

The extension is necessitated by other deadlines and work obligations, including counsel for the Respondent Limehouse's participation in an arbitration trial scheduled for December 3 – 5, 2013, in Charleston, South Carolina, an advance preparation for same, that prevent counsel for Respondent Limehouse from completing an Initial Brief and Designation of matter on behalf of Respondent Limehouse within the current deadline. One extension of time was previously requested on behalf of all Respondents and granted by Order filed November 1, 2013, with said Order resulting in the current deadline of December 4, 2013.

Additionally, the undersigned Respondents request that all filing/service deadlines be held in abeyance pending the Court's ruling on this motion.

Counsel for the Respondent Limehouse has consulted with counsel for the Appellant who graciously consents to this extension.


