Dear Brenda,

Thank you for your time on the phone this week. Attached is the Rule 605 request form with our information for NBC network news for the coverage of the oral arguments in the Alex Murdaugh appeal.

If the court continues the practice of having ETV record and live stream the oral arguments in this case, we request the ability to plug into this feed to record proceedings for our use. This requires minimal space and we are happy to coordinate with the person at ETV that handles this for the court. We are quite used to working in a pool situation that Rule 605 often provides. Besides the technical person who runs the feed for us, we would like to have 4 seats in the chamber for the NBC correspondents and producers who will attend the event.

We have some miscellaneous questions.

1. Will/could ETC provide a two-camera feed? That is, one view to the justices and the other view toward the attorney giving their presentations.
2. Is there designated parking? Or do we arrange on our own?
3. Would you like the names of the personnel we are sending to the court in advance?
4. Should our personnel bring anything kind of ID other than their employee ID cards?
5. Will we be allowed to take notes on iPads or laptops?
6. Does the court require clear tote bags to carry notebooks and other material into the chamber?

7. Are their other guidelines we should be aware of?

Please let me know if you have any questions for us and we look forward to working with you and your staff.
