1 THE COURT: All right. Go ahead and swear him in.

2 (Whereupon, the defendant was duly sworn.)

3 THE COURT: All right. You are Sammy Rowdy Parker or
4 Rowdy?

5 MR. PARKER: Rowdy.

6 THE COURT: Rowdy Parker. You're 54 years of age. Is
7 that correct?

8 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

9 THE COURT: You married?

10 MR. PARKER: No, sir.

11 THE COURT: You have children?

12 MR. PARKER: No, sir.

13 THE COURT: How far did you go in school?

14 MR. PARKER: High school.

15 THE COURT: Did you graduate?

16 MR. PARKER: Yeah.

17 THE COURT: All right. And you're represented by Mr.
18 McKinnon. Is that correct?

19 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

20 THE COURT: You're satisfied with the advice and
21 counsel he's given you?

22 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

23 THE COURT: Do you have any complaints today against
24 your lawyer, the solicitor's office or anybody?

25 MR. PARKER: No.

1 THE COURT: All right. I've got several indictments.
2 I'm going to ask you about each one so listen very carefully
3 to me.

4 On this first indictment ending in 05003, coming out
5 of York County, charges you with receiving stolen goods;
6 this being a third or subsequent offense. Now, under this
7 particular statute, I can give you up to 10 years in prison.
8 You understand that?

9 MR. PARKER: (Nods head affirmatively)

10 THE COURT: You got to say yes or no.

11 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

12 THE COURT: See that lady that's over there? She has
13 to take down everything that comes out your mouth.

14 All right. This indictment alleges that this occurred
15 on or about the 30th day of June of this year. Is that
16 correct?

17 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

18 THE COURT: That you had received stolen goods that you
19 knew were stolen. Is that correct?

20 MR. PARKER: No, sir. I didn't know it was stolen at
21 the time.

22 THE COURT: But you subsequently found out that it was
23 stolen?

24 MR. PARKER: Yeah. I found out quick.

25 THE COURT: All right. And you ran to the police

1 off- -- you ran into the police department and said, listen,
2 I got some stolen goods. I need to get them off my hands.
3 Did you do that?

4 MR. PARKER: No, sir.

5 THE COURT: Okay. All right. Let's go to the next
6 indictment ending in 05002, charge you with failure to stop
7 for a blue light. In this particular offense, I can give
8 you up to three years and a fine of up to \$500. You
9 understand that?

10 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

11 THE COURT: But in this particular indictment it
12 alleges that this occurred in York County on or about the
13 20th day of June, that you did fail to stop for a law
14 enforcement vehicle when you were summoned to do so. Is
15 that correct?

16 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

17 THE COURT: All right. This next indictment, also
18 coming out of York County, ending in 01328, charges you with
19 trafficking methamphetamine 28 grams or more. You
20 understand I can give you not less than 7 years and up to 30
21 years and a fine up to \$50,000?

22 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

23 THE COURT: This is listed as a violent offense and a
24 serious offense and I'm sure your lawyer has gone over that
25 with you. Is that correct?

1 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

2 THE COURT: This indictment alleges that you -- that
3 this occurred on or about the 28th day of February, that you
4 did have in your possession 28 grams or more of
5 methamphetamine. Is that true?

6 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

7 THE COURT: All right. The next indictment also
8 emanating out of York County, ending in 01326, charge you
9 with distribution of methamphetamine third or subsequent
10 offense, listed as also non-violent but serious. Do you
11 understand I can give you up to 10 years to 30 years and a
12 fine of up to \$50,000?

13 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

14 THE COURT: This allegedly occurred on or about the
15 21st day of February of this year. You agree with that?

16 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

17 THE COURT: That you had that in your possession. Is
18 that correct?

19 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

20 THE COURT: The next indictment ending in 06000, also
21 coming out of York County, charge you trafficking
22 methamphetamine 10 grams or more, this being the second
23 offense. Do you understand I can give you anywhere between
24 5 to 30 years in prison and a fine of up to \$50,000?

25 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

1 THE COURT: And this allegedly occurred on or about the
2 21st day of September of 2022, that you did have in your
3 possession, actual or construction possession, of 10 grams
4 or more of methamphetamine as set forth in the statute. You
5 understand that?

6 MR. PARKER: Yes.

7 THE COURT: Now, during your discussions with your
8 lawyer, Mr. McKinnon, did he also -- did he tell you that
9 once you come to court and plead guilty to any criminal
10 offense, you waive or give up certain criminal -- I mean,
11 certain constitutional rights. Now, so this is what you
12 waive or give up. You're no longer are afforded a trial
13 when you plead guilty. You understand that?

14 MR. PARKER: Yeah.

15 THE COURT: You give up your right to remain silent.
16 You give up your right to confront any witnesses that the
17 State may have against you in any of these indictments, and
18 you give up your right to assert any defense that you may
19 have in any of these indictments. They all go out the
20 window when you plead guilty. Is that what you want to do?

21 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

22 THE COURT: That's your decision?

23 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

24 THE COURT: That's not your lawyer's decision?

25 MR. PARKER: No.

1 THE COURT: All right. You're clear-minded. You
2 understand what you're doing?

3 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

4 THE COURT: Do you have any questions of me?

5 MR. PARKER: No, sir.

6 THE COURT: All right. Madam Solicitor's going to tell
7 me about the facts in each one of these cases. You listen
8 very carefully and then I'm going to come back to you and
9 your lawyer. And it's my understanding this is a negotiated
10 plea so you've talked to Mr. McKinnon about the terms of the
11 negotiation. Is that correct?

12 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

13 THE COURT: Do you need any additional time to speak
14 with him?

15 MR. PARKER: No, sir.

16 THE COURT: All right. Yes, ma'am.

17 MS. HAMILTON: Thank you, Your Honor. On the
18 trafficking offense, the first one on September 21st, 2022,
19 the defendant was pulled over for a traffic violation in
20 York County. His driver's license was found to be
21 suspended. Officers searched the vehicle prior to tow and
22 located 14.39 grams of methamphetamine in a bag that
23 contained the defendant's wallet and ID. Defendant has a
24 prior conviction for possession of meth from 2021 and 2022,
25 making this his third offense.

1 THE COURT: All right.

2 MS. HAMILTON: The next incident is going to be the
3 distribution of methamphetamine third or subsequent offense.
4 That occurred on February 21st of this year. The defendant
5 met with a confidential informant at [REDACTED] Carpenter Parker
6 Lane within York County and distributed 2.5 grams of
7 methamphetamine to the confidential informant in exchange
8 for \$60. Again, he has a prior conviction for drug
9 offenses, making this his third offense.

10 Next incident is trafficking methamphetamine that
11 occurred on February 28th, 2024. Officers executed a search
12 warrant on the defendant's residence at [REDACTED] Carpenter Parker
13 Lane. Officers located the defendant walking down the
14 stairs of the home. Upon a subsequent search of that home,
15 officers located a total of 32.58 grams of methamphetamine.
16 The defendant was subsequently interviewed and he stated
17 that he sells an 8 ball of meth for \$100. He stated he
18 purchases 1 to 2 ounces of meth at a time.

19 The final incidences occurred -- failure to stop for a
20 blue light, receiving stolen goods occurred on June 30th,
21 2024, where officers observed his vehicle -- observed a
22 vehicle that matched a description for a Flock hit earlier
23 for a stolen vehicle. The vehicle was sitting in the
24 parking at a Circle K in York County on Cherry Road.
25 Officers initiated a traffic stop on that vehicle and then

1 the defendant was the driver. That vehicle continued at a
2 high rate of speed all the way down Celanese Road, getting
3 onto I-77 northbound to Charlotte. It was confirmed over
4 the radio, as that pursuit was going on, that officers
5 confirmed it was a stolen vehicle. The defendant got up to
6 speeds continuing on I-77 of 120 miles per hour. He
7 subsequently exited -- oh. Actually went into Charlotte,
8 North Carolina on I-77, but appeared to slow down due to
9 engine problems on the car. The vehicle slowed down to 40
10 miles per hour on I-77, drove through a median to get onto
11 485. Officers continued pursuant of the vehicle until it
12 subsequently crashed. The defendant did, at that time,
13 climb through the driver's window and bush-bond, meaning
14 fled from the vehicle. They had to have K9 come. Charlotte
15 PD had to have that K9 come, accompany into the woods and
16 found the defendant 20 feet down an embankment lying on his
17 back. The vehicle was stolen.

18 THE COURT: All right. And I've got his prior record
19 in front of me, so I don't think there's any need -- it goes
20 back to 1987 and it's -- goes back -- sir, you've been
21 involved in some degree of criminality ever since you were
22 18 years of age.

23 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

24 THE COURT: Is that right? And now you're 54 years of
25 age---

1 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

2 THE COURT: ---and still doing the same thing. You
3 agree with the facts as outlined by Madam Solicitor?

4 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir.

5 THE COURT: All right. I'll go ahead and accept the
6 plea as being freely and voluntarily entered as to all these
7 indictments. Recommendation is what, Madam Solicitor?

8 MS. HAMILTON: The negotiation is 15 years, Your Honor.
9 I have credit for 307 days.

10 (Discussion off the record between Ms. Hamilton and Mr.
11 McKinnon)

12 MS. HAMILTON: Oh. Thirteen. Thirteen years
13 apparently, Your Honor. He has credit for 307 days. I know
14 that the defense is going to question the amount of credit
15 for time served, stating that he deserves more. Under the
16 new bond law, he is not entitled for credit for any time
17 past his subsequent arrest and bonding out back in 2022.

18 THE COURT: That's what the order says.

19 MR. MCKINNON: Your Honor, he has 308 days as of that
20 first arrest. He got 56 days on the second arrest and he's
21 now at 105 on his third arrest, for a total of 469 days. I
22 understand that -- what the statute says, however, my point
23 to the Court is I would be objecting to Your Honor not
24 giving him all that credit based on it being
25 unconstitutional in my view to keep the Court from being

1 able to give someone jail for time they've actually served
2 incarcerated.

3 THE COURT: You know, I've heard that argument so many
4 times, counsel, for all -- every circuit, some lawyer's
5 making that same argument, and you know what I say? I say
6 challenge it. Let the Court's determine the --

7 MR. MCKINNON: Your Honor, that's why I'm objecting to
8 it. I understand what you're going to do, so --

9 THE COURT: I know. You know what I'm going to do.

10 MR. MCKINNON: Yes, sir.

11 THE COURT: But it's up to y'all. Y'all don't like it,
12 challenge it and let those people who people who check my
13 homework take a look at it.

14 MR. MCKINNON: Yes, sir. I've discussed that fact that
15 we'll probably appeal this with Mr. Parker.

16 THE COURT: Yeah. And you might be the lead case on
17 that.

18 MR. MCKINNON: Yes. This is the first time it's
19 actually come up for me in court, so --

20 THE COURT: You may be famous.

21 MR. MCKINNON: That would be great.

22 THE COURT: Anything you want to say, Mr. Parker?

23 MR. PARKER: Yes, sir. My co-defendant,---

24 THE COURT: Uh-huh.

25 MR. PARKER: ---since I got charged with all this, can

1 y'all just let her go with time served or -- let her get on
2 home to her kids.

3 THE COURT: Well, I don't know if that works that way,
4 Mr. Parker.

5 MR. PARKER: I know. I'm just asking -- I'm just
6 asking the Court.

7 THE COURT: I don't have pardon power. I don't get to
8 do that. Y'all know what he's talking about? You know what
9 he's talking about?

10 MS. HAMILTON: I do know what he's talking about.

11 THE COURT: Okay. Well, that's not before me.

12 MS. HAMILTON: Yes.

13 THE COURT: Okay. That's a conversation I don't -- I'm
14 not involved with. All right. The lead indictment being
15 indictment ending in 01328, *State versus Sammy Rowdy Parker*,
16 the sentence of the Court is you be committed to the South
17 Carolina Department of Corrections for a period of 15 years,
18 307 days of jail credit is given to you.

19 MR. MCKINNON: Your Honor, if I can interject there.

20 THE COURT: All right.

21 MR. MCKINNON: Originally it was 15, but--

22 THE COURT: Oh. Thirteen.

23 MR. MCKINNON: ---it's 13.

24 THE COURT: Thirteen.

25 MR. MCKINNON: Yes, sir. Thank you.

1 THE COURT: Thank you. Thirteen years, 307 or 308
2 days?

3 MR. MCKINNON: I have 308, but it's one day.

4 THE COURT: All right. 307 days of credit is given to
5 him.

6 On indictment ending in 01326, the sentence of the
7 Court is be committed to the South Carolina Department of
8 Corrections for a period of 13 years, 307 days of jail
9 credit is given to you.

10 On indictment ending in 06000, the sentence of the
11 Court is you be committed to the South Carolina Department
12 of Corrections for period of 13 years. That sentence will
13 be ran concurrent with the prior two sentences.

14 On indictment ending in 05003, the sentence of the
15 Court is three years concurrent with the prior sentences;
16 and then on indictment, which is the failure to stop for a
17 blue light offense, indictment ending on 05002, the sentence
18 of the Court is time served and I've signed the order
19 lifting the bench warrant.

20 MS. HAMILTON: Thank you, Your Honor.

21 THE COURT: All right.

22 MR. MCKINNON: Thank you, Your Honor.

23 THE COURT: All right.

24 MR. MCKINNON: And, Your Honor, one more time, I'm
25 objecting to time served credit.

1 THE COURT: Yes; yes. Yes, sir. The record is so
2 noted.

3 MR. MCKINNON: Thank you.







RULE 203(B) EXPLANATION

Pursuant to Rule 203(B)(iv), the issue to be raised on appeal is whether the trial court erred in limiting the Defendant's time served credit to the time spent in pre-trial detention to his first arrest, on or about 9-21-2022. He was subsequently arrested on 2-28-2024, then again on 6-30-2024. Pursuant to 24-13-40 (3) of the South Carolina Code of Law as amended on June 20th 2023, the State asked the Judge to limit Parker's time served credit to just the 307 days that Mr. Parker spent in detention for the 2-28-2022 arrest, and to deny him any time served credit for his time spent in detention for his subsequent two arrests. The Judge followed the State's request. I objected to the Judge's decision, believing 24-13-40 (3) as amended as unconstitutional. Denying an inmate credit for time actually spent incarcerated in jail, is cruel and unusual punishment, and denies that inmate due process. The legislature's attempt to take a Judge's sentencing discretion from him also violates separation of powers. When the Judge read his sentence, I renewed my objection.
