respectfully moves the court pursuant to Rule 263(b) and  
240 of the South Carolina Appellant Court Rules (SCACR)  
for a sixty (60) day extension of time and a court  
order against respondent to provide appellant with

legal documents to be presented to this court and  
others as follows:

Appellant is a inmate in the South Carolina Department of Corrections and currently housed at Tyger River Correctional Institution. Appellant has a pending case in the South Carolina Court of Appeals on proceedings pro se and all of his motions and pleadings to the courts and hand written or type up with a type writer. SCDC or respondent does not allow inmate to create legal documents on their computer and don't have any persons trained in the law to help assist other inmate with their legal work.

In addition, SCDC Policy Procedure GA-01.03, inmate access to the court: specifically states, "quote" (12.2) materials and documents that will not be copied include: "Documents that have been solely originated, generated, written, typed, or created by an inmate (the inmate may copy this information by hand)."

Appellant is unable to send a copy to Respondents attorneys of his hand written Pleadings and type written documents because respondents SCDC personal are preventing all inmate generated legal Pleadings to the courts from being copied.

In addition, Appellant respectfully requests this order and extension of time as a result of other pending litigation commitments, and having such a short time by the S.C. Court of Appeal (10 days) to file the court ordered Pleadings.
