Brian Randall Sease appeals his conviction and sentence in this case in addition to the General Sessions Court's denial of his motion for a new trial or in the alternative resentencing.

On September 15, 2025, the Defendant was found guilty of Voluntary Manslaughter, Armed Robbery and Possession of a Weapon During a Violent Crime. Accordingly, the Honorable Deadra L. Jefferson sentenced Sease to 30 years on Voluntary Manslaughter, to 18 years on Armed Robbery, and to 5 years on the Possession of a Weapon During a Violent Crime.

On September 25, 2025, Sease filed a motion for a new trial or in the alternative resentencing within 10 days of his conviction date, per Rule 29 of the South Carolina Rules of Criminal Procedure, and on October 3, 2025, the State filed a response to Sease's motion.

On January 9, 2025, the General Sessions Court issued an order denying Sease's motion for a new trial or in the alternative resentencing with written notice of the order received by Sease's attorney on January 12, 2026.

On January 13, 2025, Sease filed a Notice of Appeal with the South Carolina Court of Appeals without making the appropriate redactions in his filing and without clearly stating when his attorneys received the order by the General Sessions Court denying his motion for a new trial or in the alternative resentencing.


In response, on January 15, 2026, the Court of Appeals sent Sease a deficiency letter regarding his Notice of Appeal. This Amended Notice of Appeal addresses the matters raised by the Court of Appeals in their recent deficiency letter to Sease, making the appropriate redactions and stating above when a final order was entered in his case by the General Sessions Court and received by his attorneys. A copy of the final order was attached to Sease's initial Notice of Appeal, and to avoid further confusion, it has been attached to his Amended Notice of Appeal.


