State with the Supreme Court on December 15, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Travontae Mitchell before the Court of Appeals on December 9, 2025. Counsel filed the Return to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of Ronnie C. Swofford v. State with the Supreme Court on November 26, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Terry Gridine before the Supreme Court on November 18, 2025. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Genari McNeil before the Court of Appeals on November 12, 2025.


