Petitioner’s Motion for an Extension to File Reply Brief

Petitioner Airbnb, Inc. (“Airbnb”) moves under Rules 208(a)(3) and 240, SCACR, for a five-day extension of time to file its Reply in Support of its Petition for a Writ of Certiorari. If granted, the new deadline would run through Monday, February 9, 2026.

Respondent Julianne Foster filed a Return in Opposition on Wednesday, January 21, 2026. As a result, Airbnb’s ten-day deadline to file its reply would fall on Monday, February 2, 2026. Rule 242(g), SCACR.

Airbnb's lead appellate counsel is out of the country this week. Undersigned counsel is preparing and appearing for an oral argument and trial over the next week. In light of these competing obligations and deadlines, Airbnb requests an additional five days from its current deadline to file its Reply Brief. The proposed extended deadline would run through Monday, February 9, 2026. The very brief extension requested will not prejudice any party.

This is Airbnb's first request for an extension of time from this Court at the certiorari stage. As a result, Airbnb has not sought any extensions against the 20-day limitation imposed by *In re Extensions in Cases Seeking a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to Review a Decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals* (S.C. Sup. Ct. July 16, 2014).

Petitioner respectfully requests the Court hold the current deadline in abeyance pending the Court's consideration of this Motion.
