**AMENDED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE APPELLANT'S
INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

Appellant Mandy Matney hereby moves for a 45-day extension of time within which to file her initial brief and designation of matter to the record on appeal. See Rule 263(b), SCACR. The motion is made on the grounds that, due to scheduling demands, additional time is needed to prepare and file the initial brief and designation of matter. In addition, a hearing on Ms. Matney's pending motion to stay the order on appeal is scheduled before the Court of Common Pleas on February 6, 2026. This is Appellant's first amended request for an extension, and it is not intended for purposes of delay.

Appellant's Notice of Appeal was timely filed in Richland County Court of Common Pleas and electronically served on counsel for Respondents on November

24, 2025. No transcript was ordered for the hearings giving rise to the orders being challenged on appeal. By operation of Rule 208(a), SCACR, Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter were due within thirty (30) days after serving the notice of appeal, or on or before December 29, 2025. On December 29, 2025 Appellant filed her Notice of Appeal with this Court and her initial Motion for Extension of Time.

Undersigned counsel received correspondence from this Court on January 12, 2026 outlining deficiencies in Appellant's December 29, 2025 filings. As of the filing of the instant Amended Motion, the undersigned believes those deficiencies have been corrected. In this Amended Motion, Appellant seeks the same extension of time as her original motion.

By the undersigned's calculation, the extension, if granted, would result in a new deadline of February 12, 2026, six days after the hearing on Appellant's motion to stay the order being appealed.
