MOTION FOR APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL

Comes Now Terrell McCoy, requesting for Appointment of Counsel in the above appellate case. This request for appointment of Counsel is necessary due to extraordinary circumstances, and Constitutional violation claims involved.
