EMERGENCY RENEWED PETITION FOR WRIT OF SUPERSEDEAS AND NOTICE OF PROCEDURAL DEFICIENCIES IN LOWER COURT

TO THE HONORABLE CLERK AND JUDGES OF THE COURT OF APPEALS:

PENDING MOTION:

Appellant filed an Emergency Motion for Stay/Supersedeas under Rule 241, SCACR on January 28, 2026. No ruling has been issued despite an approaching life-threatening winter storm.

LOWER COURT FAILURE TO RULE:

This appeal arises in part because the Circuit Court failed to rule on three (3) separate Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) requests filed by Appellant to stop Respondent's retaliatory and harassing conduct. The lower court's inaction has forced this emergency to the Appellate level.

VIOLATION OF WRITTEN AGREEMENT:

Specific "Safeguard Boundaries" were established and agreed upon in writing via email between the parties, requiring all communication to be electronic and prohibiting unauthorized physical approach. Respondent is currently in breach of these agreed-upon terms, necessitating immediate judicial intervention.

IMMEDIATE THREAT:

Appellant has documented heart and medical conditions. With a Winter Storm Warning in effect and temperatures dropping into the single digits, Respondent's continued harassment and attempted entries pose a direct threat to Appellant's life.

RELIEF SOUGHT:

Pursuant to Rule 241, Appellant demands a Writ of Supersedeas to stay all lower court proceedings and an Emergency TRO to enforce the existing written "no-contact" agreement pending the resolution of the Motion to Vacate.

**[PROPOSED] EMERGENCY ORDER GRANTING WRIT OF SUPERSEDEAS
AND TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER**

This matter comes before the Court on Appellant Sylecia McIntyre's **Emergency Renewed Petition for Writ of Supersedeas and Notice of Procedural Deficiencies**, pursuant to **Rule 241, SCACR**.

The Court finds that Appellant has demonstrated:

1. **Irreparable Harm:** Imminent risk to health and safety due to documented medical conditions and a pending life-threatening winter storm.
2. **Procedural History:** The lower court has failed to rule on three (3) prior requests for injunctive relief, necessitating this Court's intervention to preserve the status quo.
3. **Breach of Agreement:** Credible evidence that Respondent has failed to adhere to written communication and boundary safeguards.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. **Writ of Supersedeas:** All proceedings in the lower court, including any attempts at property entry, inspection, or eviction, are hereby **STAYED** pending further order of this Court.
2. **Temporary Restraining Order:** Respondent and her agents are strictly prohibited from any physical entry or approach to Appellant's residence.
3. **No-Contact Provision:** All communication between the parties shall be conducted exclusively through electronic mail as previously agreed.
4. **Enforcement:** This Order is effective immediately.
