The Appellants are writing to inform the Court of an inadvertent duplicate filing and to respectfully request that the Court disregard the hard copy that is being delivered by U.S. Postal Service Priority Mail today.

On Thursday, January 29, 2026, Appellant mailed a hard copy of the Reply via U.S. Postal Service Priority Mail for filing with the Court.
