ORDER

On January 5, 2026, Respondent filed a motion to compel Appellant to supplement the record on appeal to include all designated matters. On January 20, 2026, Appellant moved for (1) an extension of time and (2) an order requiring Respondent to provide Appellant with copies of handwritten and typed legal documents to be presented to this court and others due to the South Carolina Department of Corrections' policy prohibiting the copying of certain documents. After careful consideration of the filings, we grant Respondent's motion to compel Appellant to serve and file a record on appeal containing all designated matters, deny Appellant's motion for an order requiring Respondent provide copies of certain documents to Appellant, and grant Appellant's motion for an extension of time. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file the record on appeal containing all designated matters. *See* Rule 210(a), SCACR (explaining the appellant is responsible for serving the record on appeal); Rule 210(b), SCACR (explaining the appellant is responsible for filing the record on appeal); Rule 210(c), SCACR (stating the record on appeal "shall include all matter designated to be included by any party"). Failure to comply will result in dismissal of the appeal.
