Mr. Spradley,

I received the attached letter from the Appellate Court regarding the transcript from 11/20/2025 in Appeal Case No. 2025CP4100100 heard by Judge Hocker in Saluda County. Apparently the transcript was completed and sent out via email to the payor on January 7 2026 by Velvet Mills at Legal Eagle, the Court was notified, but I didn't receive it at that time. Further confusion was perhaps caused by the case number being misidentified on the Transcript itself, and no reference of the case number in the body of the email. sent to the Payor. Both transcripts regarding this case have since been filed with the Appellate Court as of 1/30/2026. I filed these as soon as both were obtained by myself.

This attached letter prompted me to search for the transcript. And, although I was CC'd in an email from the transcriptionist, as indicated in a forwarded copy sent to the payor of the order fee for the transcript (Sandra Holmwood), for some reason it was not received by me via email. And since the email did not appear in my Inbox or Spam folder, despite the email address being correct, I had only just received notice and a copy of this transcript for the first time on January 29, 2026.

I intend on submitting an extension request in the form of a Motion to the Appellate Court to grant me leave until February 28th, 2026 to file my Initial Brief and Designation. If you have no objection and consent to this extension as Respondent's Counsel, I will reference your consent in the Motion To Request Extension. I will be filing this Motion in the next day or so and will notice you with a copy either way. Of course, you would still have your 30 days to respond to my Initial Brief with yours, until March 30, 2026 or 30 days after my filing which would likely be sooner than Feb 28, 2026 with the Court's permission.
