Dear Clerk of the South Carolina Court of Appeals,

This email submits an **Emergency Motion to Stay Pending Appeal** pursuant to Rule 262, SCACR, due to **imminent and irreparable harm** arising from a **Writ of Ejectment dated February 6, 2026**, which is subject to immediate execution.

This case is presently **pending before the Court of Appeals** (Appellate Case No. 2025-002352). Enforcement of the writ would alter possession and the status quo before appellate supervision can be exercised, risking mootness of appellate review.

The emergency arises from a **jurisdictional overreach**: the writ was signed by a magistrate court despite the matter having proceeded to **Common Pleas and now appellate jurisdiction**, and despite magistrate courts being courts of **limited civil jurisdiction**, including a \$7,500 ceiling. This motion is not accusatory; it is submitted to ensure the Court is aware of a **non-discretionary jurisdictional conflict requiring immediate restraint** pending review.
