By way of further status update in the above-referenced case, after the November 14, 2025, hearing, the trial court issued the Order Awarding Plaintiff Attorney's Fees and Costs and Denying Defendant Miller's Motion to Lift Automatic Stay. Defendant Amanda Shadon Miller filed a Motion to Alter/Amend on December 11, 2025. The Motion to Alter/Amend was scheduled to be heard by the trial court on January 30, 2026.
