

ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion to reinstate this appeal, which was dismissed for failure to pay the notice of appeal filing fee. Appellant argues he should not be required to pay filing fees. We agree. Appellant's motion is granted, and this appeal is reinstated. Furthermore, because the underlying orders concern Appellant's parole eligibility, Appellant is entitled to proceed without costs. See *Furtick v. S. Carolina Dep't of Prob., Parole & Pardon Servs.*, 352 S.C. 594, 598, 576 S.E.2d 146, 149 (2003) (providing the permanent denial of parole eligibility implicates a liberty interest).
