AMENDED INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT


Appellant, through his undersigned counsel, would respectfully show unto this Court as follows:

1. Undersigned counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant, yesterday, February 5, 2026, with this Court.
2. This morning, while reviewing the clocked copy of the initial brief, counsel noticed an oversight in the Statement of Issues on Appeal concerning issue three. This oversight also appears in the argument heading for the third issue on page 30 of the initial brief, on page 31 at the beginning of the discussion for the third issue, and on page 36 in the conclusion for the third issue.

3. More specifically, undersigned counsel wrote “the evidence showed Appellant *either acted with malice or in self-defense.*” Undersigned counsel respectfully requests this Court allow counsel to file an amended initial brief of appellant removing the italicized words above as there is no evidence Appellant acted with malice. This sentence would be amended to state “the evidence showed Appellant acted in self-defense.”
4. Undersigned counsel deeply regrets this oversight as it undermines the arguments Appellant raised during trial and on appeal, and respectfully requests this Court allow counsel to file an amended initial brief of appellant to correct this oversight.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests this Court grant the motion to file an Amended Initial Brief of Appellant and accept the Amended Initial Brief of Appellant, which is being filed simultaneously with this motion.


