Please clarify.

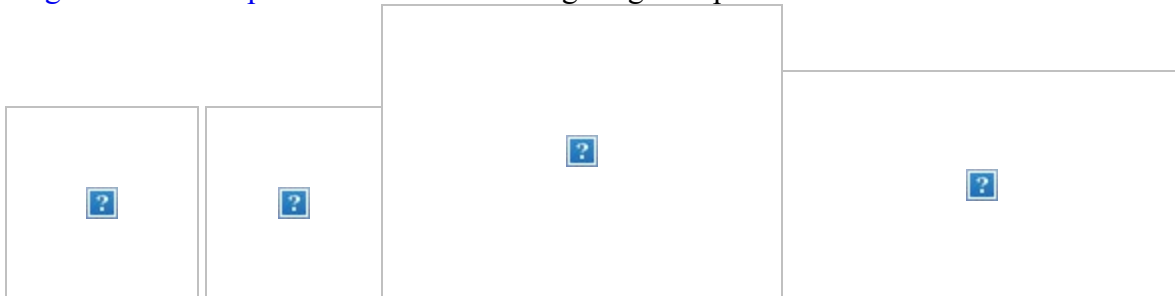
