However, as of this date, the backpay has not been deposited into my E.H. Cooper account, and this have been going on since the ruling on October 21, 2025, stating I should receive the funds "in the near future."

Ms. Kitchings, I'm not going to pursue an appeal if SCDC officials just deposit the backpay into my account, but as it stands, I know understand the problem for the delay to do so. Also, I have enclosed a copy of a letter dated December 2, 2025, signed by Judge Crystal M. Rookard, SCALJ, but as of this date, she has not made a ruling on my Motion of Writ of Mandamus regarding the matter.

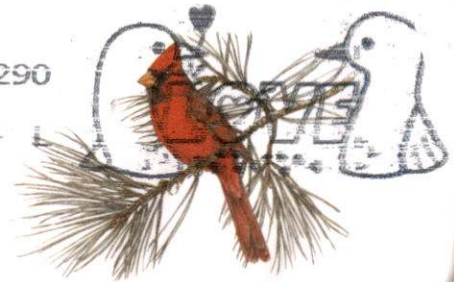
