

ORDER


By order dated December 16, 2025, this Court granted Appellant's motion to dismiss the appeal. Respondents now move for an award of costs under Rule 222, SCACR, and the imposition of a sanction under Rule 269, SCACR. The request for costs is granted in part in the amount of \$2,607.59, to be taxed against Appellant. The request for a sanction is denied. The lower court is directed to add the award of costs to the remittitur.


