"Unreasonable and Invalid Indictments"

This information I have uncovered solely due to

this unjust conviction, which is a clear Constitutional violation of my 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment along with the previous brief supporting the 4<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment violations.

First and Foremost solicitor Marina Bender Hamilton failed to meet South Carolina Rules of Criminal Procedure

"Rule 3 Disposition of Arrest Warrants (c) and (d).

The indictments were presented as stated by the enclosed indictments catalog on 10/26/2023. The indictments I was convicted on were presented after the (90) day requirement, which Mrs. Hamilton failed to take action within (90) days as stated in (c), Action on Warrant, by not preparing the indictment in the time allowed as required. Mrs. Hamilton did not present a petition to the Circuit Court for an order delaying action on the warrant, as set forth above, I've written a Matthew Miemiec and Wanda H. Conter pertaining to an order for extension of time and have yet to be provided with such information, for successive ninety (90) day periods if the circuit court specifically found good cause. Mrs. Hamilton's failure to meet the (90) day deadline without a proper extension was a violation of my procedural rights. The warrants

were not dismissed on the indictments were not filed within (90) days, and no extension was ever granted. The Validity of the subsequent indictments became invalid due to the delay. A circuit court does not have subject matter jurisdiction to hear a case or accept a plea unless there is a valid indictment. The indictments for my conviction are defective and the procedural mandates required for jurisdiction were not met, any subsequent judgement or conviction is considered void. I have enclosed Documents to support no extension ever being on record. I have also enclosed 490 indictments that were "True Billed" in one day. 490 indictments indicted in one day is to be considered highly unusual and potentially rushed, as it allows 1.2 minutes per indictments. This action raises procedural concerns about the depth of the deliberation and the risk of prejudice against plenty that are accused. A York County judge ruled that 904 indictments in a 10 hour period were invalid because they imposed an "Unreasonable Burden" on Jurors. The court noted that processing this many cases averaged 39 seconds per case, which eroded public confidence in the justice system. 490

indictments issued in 10 hours is unreasonable, my argument is the grand jury failed its constitutional duty as an independent "shield" rather than a mere "rubber stamp" for the prosecution. I am asking this court to consider the "Average Time Per Case." For instance 490 indictments in 10 hours averages roughly 1.2 minutes per case, a rate that is imposing an "Unreasonable Burden" that prevents meaningful consideration of evidence.

The complexity of my case alone involved complex litigation, multiple defendants, and extensive documentation.

This high-volume day is more likely to be found unreasonable if it includes complex felony charges (My case) that required detailed factual analysis.

The procedural requirements timeframe (1.2 minutes per case) suggest these steps were bypassed and handled perfunctorily, my indictments are very vulnerable to challenge. "Public Confidence", judicial rulings emphasize that extreme speed in processing hundreds of cases can erode public trust in the legal system's integrity, leading to a finding of unreasonableness even if technical rules were followed. Based on legal precedents, specifically a notable "2018 York County Case" in South

Carolina, mass processing hundreds of indictments in a single day, if argued can be ruled as unconstitutional as it violates due process rights of the accused by not allowing a grand jury sufficient time to act as a meaningful check on prosecution. A judgement that stems from an unconstitutional process may render the conviction void, potentially allowing for release. The 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment requires a proper indictment by a grand jury, and when that process is rushed to the point of being a "Rubber Stamp" it violates due process. Courts have held that if a sentence is based on a violated due process. Courts have held that if a sentence is based on a violated constitutional right, it is void. In this scenario the grand jury relied on an officer Laurencio who had no actual knowledge of the events, to present a summary, than in depth testimony from actual officers who had knowledge on physical evidence, which in this conviction, was submitted August 24, 2023 and the Date of the report was December 15, 2023, with the Laboratory results being reported back in December as to the evidence, How was any evidence presented on October 26, 2023, to the grand jury? Such high volume, rapid fire indictment process can

be considered inappropriate. Neither the arresting officer nor any person with personal knowledge of the case was present. How could a grand jury return a "True Bill" when the officer has no knowledge of the case? On Aug 17, 2018 Circuit Judge Dan Hall wrote "Public Confidence" in our system is eroded by the grand jury being asked to act on 904 indictments in a 10 hour period. This is a grave concern of mine due to a corrupt and improper judicial function being administered by the county of York to maintain a high conviction rate, whether just or unjust. This entire situation has become a mental battle against a Judicial system within a County that has a history of being corrupt and having a lot of other agencies investigating the Judicial system within the county of York. I have requested numerous documents that I have been denied since the very beginning of this entire case. I am asking that my concerns of lack of subject matter jurisdiction be taken into consideration due to a Due Process violation of the County of York's will to "Rubber Stamp" 490 indictments (1.2 mins per case) in 1 day.

On 10/26/2023 Indictments number 2023-GS-46-04199 and 2023-GS-46-04196A were "True Billed"; but on 1/23/25 The jury found me the appellate not guilty of those two charges. So the way it is Darker than others does not mean anything other than what my paperwork will validate. Thank You and have a Blessed Day.

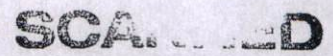

MOTION TO SUPPRESS EVIDENCE

COMES NOW the Defendant-Appellant, Londell Lashun Alston, by and through undersigned counsel, and respectfully moves this Honorable Court to suppress all evidence obtained during the traffic stop conducted on [07/14/2023], on the grounds that the stop, detention, and search violated the Fourth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution, as well as South Carolina statutory and procedural law.

---

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

1. On [07/14/2023], the Appellant was subjected to a traffic stop initiated by law enforcement for a delinquent license tag.
2. During the stop, the officer discovered a firearm in the glove box, which was lawfully stored.
3. The officer removed the Appellant from the vehicle, allegedly for officer safety, claiming the Appellant had reached for the firearm.
4. Footage from the stop clearly shows the Appellant reaching for his wallet and bank cards, not the firearm.
5. This footage directly contradicts the officer's justification for removing the Appellant from the vehicle and frisking him.
6. The subsequent frisk of the Appellant's person transitioned into an unlawful evidentiary search, during which the officer identified an object that was not a weapon and required clarification from the Appellant to identify.
7. The object was determined to be marijuana, and additional substances were later confiscated, forming the basis for the current charges.

---

LEGAL ARGUMENT

I. The Traffic Stop Was Unlawfully Prolonged in Violation of the Fourth Amendment

Under *Rodriguez v. United States*, 575 U.S. 348 (2015), a traffic stop must remain limited to its original purpose unless independent probable cause or reasonable suspicion arises.

1. The officer abandoned the original purpose of the stop (delinquent license tag) without resolving or issuing a citation.
  2. The claim that the Appellant reached for the firearm was unsupported by any objective evidence, as the footage clearly shows the Appellant reaching for his wallet and bank cards.
  3. This baseless assertion resulted in an unwarranted escalation and unlawfully prolonged the stop.
- 

## II. The Frisk Was Unjustified and Exceeded the Scope Permitted Under Terry v. Ohio

A Terry frisk is limited to addressing immediate concerns about weapons or threats to officer safety.

1. Under Terry v. Ohio, 392 U.S. 1 (1968), and Minnesota v. Dickerson, 508 U.S. 366 (1993), a frisk must be based on specific, articulable facts that suggest the individual is armed and dangerous.
  2. The officer's claim that the Appellant reached for the firearm is directly contradicted by video evidence showing no such action.
  3. Without a credible basis for suspecting the Appellant was armed and dangerous, the officer's actions in frisking the Appellant and continuing into an evidentiary search violated the Fourth Amendment.

## III. The Evidence Is the "Fruit of the Poisonous Tree"

Evidence obtained as a result of an unlawful search or detention is inadmissible under Wong Sun v. United States, 371 U.S. 471 (1963).

1. The officer's removal of the Appellant from the vehicle and subsequent frisk were premised on a false and unsupported assertion of officer safety.
  2. The marijuana and other substances confiscated during the search are directly tainted by this unlawful removal and frisk and must therefore be suppressed.

## IV. The Officer Violated South Carolina Statutory Law

Under S.C. Code § 56-7-15, officers are required to issue uniform traffic tickets for offenses occurring during a traffic stop. Additionally, S.C. Code § 56-7-6560(A) mandates that officers charge defendants for any offenses discovered during a lawful stop.

1. The officer's abandonment of the delinquent license tag charge and reliance on an unsupported officer safety claim to escalate the stop constitutes a failure to comply with statutory duties.
  2. The escalation of the stop, based on false pretenses, further undermines the legality of the detention and search.

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the Defendant-Appellant respectfully requests that this Honorable Court:

1. Grant this motion to suppress all evidence obtained during the traffic stop;
2. Vacate the Appellant's conviction and sentence based on the suppressed evidence; and
3. Dismiss all charges related to the unlawfully seized evidence.
