MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, and this Court's Order Regarding Extensions in Cases Seeking a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari (dated July 16, 2014), Petitioner Rebecca Turisk, through undersigned counsel, respectfully requests a ten (10) day extension of time to file Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Certiorari. This is Petitioner's first request for an extension of time as to this filing.

Good cause exists for the requested extension. Undersigned counsel has concurrent obligations before the Supreme Court, the Court of Appeals, and the circuit courts. These obligations include pending deadlines that cannot be deferred and that have required counsel's immediate attention during the filing period.

The Court of Appeals issued its opinion in this matter on October 15, 2025, in Unpublished Opinion No. 2025-UP-349, affirming the trial court. Petitioner timely filed a Petition for Rehearing, which was denied on January 22, 2026. Pursuant to Rule 242(c), SCACR, the Petition for Writ of Certiorari is currently due on Monday, February 23, 2026. If this Motion is granted, the new deadline will be Thursday, March 5, 2026. The requested ten (10) days falls well within the twenty (20) day cumulative limit permitted under this Court's Order Regarding Extensions, and no prior extensions have been sought or granted at any stage of these proceedings before this Court.

The extension will serve the interests of justice by allowing Petitioner's counsel adequate time to properly prepare the Petition for Writ of Certiorari. Petitioner does not request this extension for any improper purpose or to cause delay.

Petitioner also respectfully requests that this Court hold all deadlines in this matter in abeyance until an Order has been issued on this Motion.
