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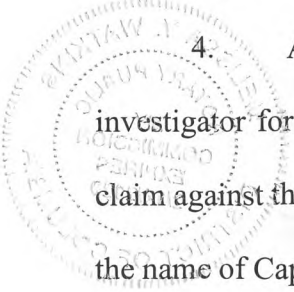
I, Tim Finley, do swear under penalty of perjury based on my own personal knowledge as follows:

1. I am a partner in the Litigation and Government Enforcement practice at Baker & McKenzie LLP. Prior to joining Baker McKenzie in mid-2025, I worked at the United States Department of Justice for 18 years, where I served at both the Antitrust Division and the Consumer Protection Branch. Most recently, I was an Assistant Director leading teams of trial attorneys and investigators working on civil and criminal enforcement actions. I have acted as lead counsel in many trials and investigations that successfully enforced antitrust and consumer protection laws.

2. During my tenure, I received the Attorney General's John Marshall Award for Litigation, the Attorney General's Award for Fraud Prevention, and a Special Commendation for Outstanding Service for my work as lead trial counsel. Before becoming a federal prosecutor, I was a partner at a major law firm, where my practice focused on litigating and trying complex commercial and antitrust cases. During my thirty-year career, I have not been the subject of any finding of professional misconduct.

3. I have reviewed the putative Receiver's Third Motion for Leave to Supplement Motion for Sanctions as to Mohed Altrad and Altrad Investment Authority S.A.S., as well as the supporting Exhibits A-F.

4. As is routine in litigation, I explored the possibility of potentially hiring a legal investigator for the purpose of identifying whether any information supports a possible federal claim against the putative Receiver based on what appears to be *ultra vires* conduct he is taking in the name of Cape Intermediate Holdings Limited.




