Dear Ms. Kitchings:

On December 1, 2025, you received and filed my Notice of Appeal from the ALC Case No. 25-ALJ-04-0136-AP; Grievance No. KRCI 0403-24, in which the ALC affirmed SCDC's determination regarding correctly calculated the hours I worked from 2005 to May 2024, owing a backpay in the amount of \$83,717.11, subject to the deductions outlined in §24-3-40(A)(1) through (A)(6) of S.C. Code (2024).

As such, upon the ALC's affirmation of SCDC's foregoing position. Appellant filed its Notice of Appeal to protect his due process rights, because SCDC seemingly did not adhere to the affirmation of the amount and statutory deductions.

For the most part, SCDC applied fraudulent backpay in the amount of \$84,032.49, gross wages, and unauthorized retroactive deductions from 2005 to January 16, 2026 in violation of §24-3-40, et seq..

I am aware that an appeal will not be appropriate in this matter, but in the interest of judicial economy, I am asking the Court may I pay the filing fee and proceed with leave to proceed with a Rule 60(b)(2)(3), SCRC Motion for Relief From Judgment of the ALC Order, dated 10/21/25.
