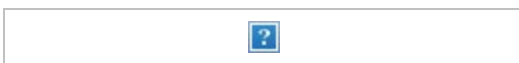

I have served all counsel in this action with a copy of this document by email under *In re Methods of Electronic Filing and Service Under Rule 262 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules*, Appellate Case No. 2020-000447 (April 24, 2024).

Because of the novel nature of proceedings under the Homeland Security Act, the procedural mechanism to enable appellate review is unclear.
