The South Carolina Department of Employment & Workforce (SCDEW) is a respondent in the above-referenced appeal. Final Briefs, originally filed with the Court of Appeals, were served March 28, 2013. Pursuant to Rule 204(b), SCACR, this Court certified the case on October 10, 2013.

Oral argument has been scheduled by the Court for Tuesday, January 7, 2014. Respondent SCDEW hereby brings to the Court's attention supplemental authority for its argument on appeal. *See* Rule 208(b)(7).<sup>1</sup>

On June 26, 2013, after the briefs in this case were finalized this Court published the following decision: *Bone v. U.S. Food Service*, 404 S.C. 67, 744 S.E.2d 552 (2013). The majority opinion in *Bone* supports Respondents' arguments on Issue I in

**Supplemental Citations.** When pertinent and significant authorities come to the attention of a party after his initial brief(s) has been served and filed, the party shall promptly advise the clerk of the appellate court, by letter, with a copy to all counsel, setting forth the citations. There shall be a reference either to the page of the brief or to an issue to which the citations pertain, but the letter shall, without argument, state the reasons for the supplemental citations. Any response shall be made promptly and shall be similarly limited.

Respondents' Brief (wherein Respondents argue that Appellant Nucor Corp. failed to appeal from a final Administrative Law Court order, and therefore this Appeal should be dismissed).<sup>2</sup>
