Collins v Doe, 352 SC 462, 574 SE2d 739 (2002) ("Where the terms

of a statute are clear, the court must apply those terms according to their literal meaning."); State v Faulkner, 274 S.C. 619, 266 S.E.2d 420 (1980) ("[An] exception must not swallow the rule."); State v Broadnax, 414 S.C. 468, 779 S.E.2d 789 (2015) (South Carolina Supreme Court recognizing ~~it~~ error for an exception to swallow the rule.) RCSH

Operations, L.L.C v Third Crystal Park Associates L.P., 115 Fed. Appx. 621 (4th Cir. 2004) ("It is precisely this sort of procedural gamesmanship caused by the circumstances presented here that Rule [6(d), S.C.R.P.] is intended to foreclose.

Gutiérrez v Saenz, No. 23-7809, 606 US 305, 145 Sct 2258 (June 26, 2025) ("Due process does not countenance procedural sleight of hand whereby a state extends a right with one hand and then takes it away with another.")

2. With regard to Appellant's issue as to the Circuit Court's failure to indicate and specifically rule as to whether the dismissal of the Complaint for lack of subject matter jurisdiction was "with" or "without" prejudice:

Myles v Thompson, No. 25-1069 (4th Cir. May 20, 2025), 2025 WL 1443954

("A dismissal for lack of subject matter jurisdiction must be without prejudice, because a court that lacks jurisdiction has no



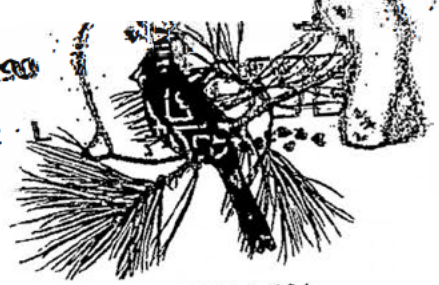
