The appellant reinjured her shoulder on Jan 1, 2026 and was attempting to avoid surgery through conservative therapy which has now failed and requires further rest of the shoulder and surgery. The re-injury prevents the appellant from typing for more than a few minutes and precludes her from completing the necessary tasks

of typing, lifting, and preparing the final documents required for the appeal. The appeal is currently held in abeyance pending the decision of the Court regarding re-hearing and a Rule 60 motion; however, I will be unable to further file and respond based on the injury and need to hold the appeal in abeyance.
