RE: Bail Appointment

Chief Judge Few:

This letter has been sent to this office to request a bail to be appointed to me with respect to Rule 246(a) SCACR (Stay in Criminal Cases), which states: The service of a notice of appeal by a criminal defendant shall operate as a stay of the execution of the sentence until the appeal is finally disposed of... Where the sentence exceeds imprisonment for (10) years, the defendant may only be admitted to bail by an appellate court.

During my time at the South Carolina Department of Corrections (SCDC), I have had zero (0) charges, zero disciplinary's, zero detainers and zero holds. I am not an escape risk in any way, and in fact, am anxiously awaiting the results of my appeal and retrial.

Several of my Constitutional Rights were violated, such as:

- Art.1 Sect.3, "Due Process;
Equal Protection of the Laws"
- Art.1 Sect.9, "Speedy Remedy"
- Art.1 Sect.10, "Searches and Seizures;
Invasions of Privacy"
- Art.1 Sect.13, "Taking Private Property"
- Art.1 Sect.14, "Witnesses; Defense"
- Art.1 Sect.15, "Detention of Witnesses"
- Art.1 Sect.23, "Provisions of Constitution
Mandatory"

I am an innocent man and a victim of an imperfect judicial system. My Initial Brief, the States Response Brief, and my Reply Brief, have all been properly filed with the court of appeals. My mother, who is my only close surviving family member, has been diagnosed with "Terminal Brain Cancer" (see attached Dr.'s letters and Insurance Forms), and needs my help. My mother is willing to use her disability payments to bring me home to help her.

Lastly, I have been utilizing my time productively by taking "Work Keys" class, working in "P.I." and am currently taking a "Paralegal Certification Course" through Blackstone Career Institute.

I am Respectfully Requesting a bail to be appointed so that I can take care of my mother, better work on my case, find appropriate representation, get a job to help support my mother and myself and finish my B.S. Degree in Computer Programming Technology and finish my certification in Paralegal studies.

I greatly appreciate your time and consideration in helping me to achieve these goals, and I will be patiently awaiting your response.
