MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Jennifer McNaughton respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from March 9, 2026 until April 8, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Jennifer McNaughton respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Erick E. Wells v. The State with the Court of Appeals on March 5, 2026. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Devonte T. Major v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 20, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Mark S. Wingo v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 13, 2026. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of James Lee McCoy, II v. The State with the Supreme Court on January 23, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Corey T. Busch with the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals on January 20, 2026. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Trampas Prater with the Court of Appeals on January 16, 2026. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Samantha Gwen Watts with the Court of Appeals on January 9, 2026. Counsel will file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. John Blauvelt with the Court of Appeals on January 7, 2026. Counsel filed the Record on Appeal in the case of State v. Nathaniel Jenkins with the Court of Appeals on December 18, 2025. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant in the case of State v. Nathaniel Jenkins with the Court of Appeals on December 17, 2025.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.






