COMES NOW Appellants, Oakbrook Healthcare, LLC d/b/a Oakbrook Health and Rehabilitation Center and Patricia Castle, by and through their undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and move for an extension of fifteen (15) days' additional time to file/serve a petition for rehearing of this matter.
