## ORDER

---

On February 4, 2026, Respondent filed its designation of matter. On February 9, 2026, Appellant filed a motion to strike and limit Respondent's designation of matter. Appellant moved this court to strike Respondent's designated items 6 and 8 through 15, arguing these items were not relevant. Alternatively, Appellant moved to limit the inclusion of the items to only those pages "actually relied upon" by the master-in-equity. Respondent filed a return, arguing all designated items were relevant to the appeal. According to Respondent, items 6 and 8 through 12 were before the lower court concerning execution on the underlying judgment, and items 13 through 15 concerned the first appeal filed by Appellant in this court and were included by Respondent to provide the complete history of the case. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion to strike and request for alternative relief.
