
Motion

## **REQUEST COURT TRANSCRIPTS THROUGH NEW TRANSCRIPT PORTAL**

Court transcripts are vital to the administration of justice because they serve as the verbatim, official record of all interactions taking place on the record, during a court proceeding. They are also an important part of the appeal process when a decision rendered in the lower court is reviewed by the appellate courts. Due to the high volume of transcript orders received by The Court Reporter Section of Court Services, and the number of court reporters involved, manually managing the transcript ordering and delivery process is no longer viable. In order to make the process more efficient and to assist with the ordering, assigning, and tracking of transcript requests the S.C. Judicial Branch has implemented an automated procedure.

Pursuant to Rules 207 and 607 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the transcribed paper copy is the official record of court proceedings. Any party or attorney representing a party, who is interested in obtaining a transcript from a court proceeding held in Circuit or Family Court must complete the Transcript Request Form, SCCA 800, to order the transcript. If the requestor is a non-party, the court reporter must obtain permission from the court (presiding judge or Chief Administrative Judge) in order to produce the transcript.

**Thursday, January 2, 2025**, will mark the launch of the new online Transcript Portal, which is designed to improve the management of the transcript request process, from ordering, production, and delivery. To order a transcript, please submit the transcript request through the new Transcript Portal request link found at <https://www.sccourts.org/courts/court-officials/court-reporters/obtain-a-transcript/>. In the event there are technical issues using the system, you may also submit SCCA Form 800, in paper form and return it via email to [transcripts@sccourts.org](mailto:transcripts@sccourts.org) or postal mail to South Carolina Court Administration, 1220 Senate Street, Columbia, SC 29201.

### **Frequently Asked Questions:**

**Q: How do I obtain a transcript request?**

*A: You need to request the transcript through the Transcript Portal found at <https://www.sccourts.org/courts/court-officials/court-reporters/obtain-a-transcript/> unless there is a technical difficulty in which case you may download the form and return it via USPS or email.*

**Q: If I have questions concerning a transcript, who do I contact?**

*A: You will need to contact [transcripts@sccourts.org](mailto:transcripts@sccourts.org).*

**Q: Can I request a transcript from a proceeding heard in Probate Court?**

*A: If you need a transcript from a court proceeding held in Municipal, Magistrate, Master-In-Equity, or Probate Court, you must contact that court directly.*


