ORDER

On December 12, 2025, Appellant filed motions to (1) file her notice of appeal out of time, (2) proceed in forma pauperis, and (3) "strike improper and irrelevant allegations and to limit argument to the merits." Respondent filed returns in opposition to Appellant's motions and Appellant did not file replies. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion to file her notice of appeal out of time. *See* Rule 203(b)(1), SCACR ("A notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order or judgment."); Rule 263, SCACR ("The time prescribed by these Rules for performing any act *except the time for serving the notice of appeal under Rules 203 and 243* may be extended or shortened by the appellate court . . .") (emphasis added). We decline to address the remaining motions as our ruling on Appellant's first motion is dispositive. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed. Remittitur will issue as provided in Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
